Dr Roxana Mehran, Mount Sinai Professor in Cardiovascular Clinical Research and Outcomes, Professor of Medicine (Cardiology) and Population Health Science and Policy at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, is an internationally renowned interventional cardiologist and clinical research expert in the field of cardiovascular disease. She has built a globally respected academic research center focused on developing randomized clinical trials and has served as Principal Investigator for numerous global studies and developed risk scores for bleeding and acute kidney injury. She participates regularly in developing clinical guidelines and has authored more than 1,000 peer-reviewed articles. She has been included for three consecutive years in Clarivate Analytics' "Most Cited Researchers –Top 1%" as well as "The World's Most Influential Scientific Minds" (Thomson Reuters).

Dr Mehran is a current member of the American College of Cardiology (ACC) Board of Trustees. She is a founder and Chief Scientific Officer of the Cardiovascular Research Foundation (CRF) and founded Women as One, dedicated to advancing opportunities for women in medicine. Dr Mehran is a recipient of several awards, including the 2016 American College of Cardiology Bernadine Healy Leadership in CV Disease Award, the 2018 Nanette Wenger Award from Women's Heart for excellence in research and education, the 2019 Ellis Island Medal of Honor and the 2019 ESC Silver Medal and Andreas Grüntzig Lecture plaque.

Prof Fausto J Pinto graduated from Lisbon University Medical School in 1984. He did his Cardiology internship at Santa Maria University Hospital – CHLN, E.P.E. (Lisbon, Portugal) and at Stanford University Medical School (California, USA), where he was a Clinical Fellow. He was then Clinical Attending in the Echocardiography laboratory and underwent an Interventional Cardiology Fellowship at the same institution.

He is currently the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Lisbon and Full Professor of Cardiology, Head of the Cardiology Department and of the Heart and Vascular Department of Santa Maria University Hospital, CHULN E.P.E. and President of the World Heart Federation (WHF) (2021-2022). He has been the National Coordinator of the Medical Schools Council (2018-2020) and President of the Executive Board of the Lisbon Academic Medical Centre (CAML) (2019-2021). He has also been the Director of Lisbon Cardiovascular Institute (ICVL) since 1999.

Prof Pinto was the President and founder of the European Association of Echocardiography (2002-04), a registered branch of the European Society of Cardiology (ESC), Chairman of the CPC (Congress Program Committee) of the ESC (2008-10), Chair of the European Heart Agency (2016-2018) and ESC President (2014-16). He is currently the President of the World Heart Federation (WHF) (2021-2022) and is on the Board of the European Heart for Children.

He is a Fellow of the European Society of Cardiology (FESC), the American College of Cardiology (FACC), the American Society of Angiology (FASA), the Society for Cardiac Angiography and Interventions (FSCAI) and the American Society of Echocardiography (FASE). He is also an Honorary Member of several international societies, including the Société Française de Cardiologie, the Sociedad Colombiana de Cardiología, the American Society of Echocardiography, the Società Italiana de Ecografia Cardiovascolare, the Hungarian Society of Cardiology, the Japanese Circulation Society and the Sociedad Peruana de Cardiología, as well as the Romanian Academy of Medical Sciences, the Romanian Society of Cardiology, the Russian Society of Cardiology and the Slovakian Society of Cardiology. He was appointed by acclamation (29 November 2018) as Honorary Member of the National Academy of Medicine of Brazil. He is the Honorary President of the International Committee for Education and Cooperation of the Italian Society of Medical Science (SISMED) and an Honorary Member of the Brazilian Society of Cardiology (Nov 2020). He was awarded the Dante Pazzanese Medal in November 2020.

Prof Pinto was the Editor in Chief of the Portuguese *Journal of Cardiology* (1999-2015) and is currently Consulting Editor and Member of the Advisory and Editorial Board of several international peer-reviewed journals and an Expert Reviewer for the European Commission. He has published over 600 indexed articles and has presented over 1500 lectures/chairmanships at national and mostly international meetings.

His main areas of interest are ischemic heart disease, anticoagulation and cardiovascular imaging, particularly on the use of ultrasound in cardiology and he pioneered the use of intravascular ultrasound in the study of graft atherosclerosis.

Corrado Tamburino, MD, PhD

Prof Corrado Tamburino became an Associate Professor of Cardiology in 1993, and in 2002 he became a Full Professor. Previously, he was an intern with medical care functions from his graduation until 1989, and hospital care from 1989 to 1993, at the Institute of Cardiology, University of Catania in Italy.

Prof Tamburino introduced endomyocardial biopsy and mitral, aortic and pulmonary valvuloplasty in Sicily, as well as all the alternative procedures to Interventional Cardiology Coronary balloon (stent, atherectomy, rotablator). He also was responsible for introducing the treatment of severe aortic disease by transcatheter aortic valve implantation and the percutaneous mitral valve regurgitation reduction by MitraClip in Italy.

Since 2004, he has directed the Complex Unit of Cardiology with Intensive Care Unit, Semi Intensive Care Unit, Cath Lab and Interventional Cardiology, Interventional Arrhythmology at Ferrarotto University Hospital in Catania.

Prof Tamburino has published over 600 articles in journals and reported or moderated in over 600 national and international conferences. He has been regularly attending the main international conferences on interventional cardiology as speaker and operator of live cases for years. He has also collaborated with foreign universities and clinical centers such as the Pitié Salpêtrière and Saint-Antoine university hospitals in Paris and the Medical Chirurgical Center Parly II in Le Chesnay, France.

Prof Tamburino was an operator of about 20,000 diagnostic and interventional procedures in hemodynamics with particular application in coronary angioplasty and stenting and in the treatment of heart valve diseases. On June 4, 2007, he was the first in Italy to perform the implantation of a biological aortic valve percutaneously on inoperable patients, and on October 7, 2008, he made the first mitral clip implant for the treatment of mitral valve prolapse. He was also the first in Italy (October 10, 2012) to perform the implantation of the Parachute System for the treatment of heart failure. Moreover, he has the most experience, in Italy, in bioresorbable scaffolds.

He has served and continues to serve in various medical society leadership positions, including currently as President of the Sicilian Regional Committee for the Network of MI. Since 2014, he has been a member of the editorial board for the *European Heart Journal*.

Prof Jose L Zamorano is a Professor of Medicine at University Alcala de Henares, Madrid and the Chief of Cardiology at University Hospital Ramón y Cajal. Prof Zamorano obtained his medical degree from University Complutense in 1987 and his Doctor in Medicine in 1991.

Prof Zamorano has a broad range of research interests including heart failure, ischemic heart disease, cardiovascular risk factors and cardiovascular imaging modalities. Within these fields, Prof Zamorano has published over 500 articles and 20 books including the *European Textbook of Cardiovascular Imaging*. His impact factor is > 1,500 and Hirsch Index of 93 with more than 98,000 citations.

Prof Zamorano is an active participant in international scientific societies. He has served as Vice President of the European Society of Cardiology (ESC), Secretary of the ESC and President of the European Association of Echocardiography (EAE). He has also been an International Advisor of the American College of Cardiology's International Committee, Director of the scientific program in imaging for the ESC Congress and Chair of the Practice Guidelines and Global Affairs committees of the ESC.

Over the past 20 years, Prof Zamorano has received a number of prestigious Spanish and international awards, such as the Golden Plaque of the Public Health Authorities of Madrid and the Inge Edler Gold Medal, the silver medal of the European Society of Cardiology, honorary member of the American Society of Echocardiography and Research Award of the Spanish Society of Cardiology. He has served on different Editorial Boards of research journals, including the *Spanish Journal of Cardiology*, the *European Journal of Echocardiography*, the *European Journal of Cardiovascular Imaging*, the *Journal of the American Society of Echocardiography*, the *European Heart Journal* and the *Journal of American College of Cardiology Cardiovascular Imaging*. He is Associate Editor of the *European Journal of Cardiovascular Imaging*.
